- who, even if only for some didactic activities, are in a condition of disability
- asylum seekers or refugees
- with other vulnerabilities

The service is intended for people with disabilities but is available to all students, employees, and schools of the University of Padua simply using their institutional email address (@unipd.it or @studenti.unipd.it).

How it works

Users have access to a variety of conversion services based on their needs:

- Audio files: MP3 and audiobooks (DAISY format)
- E-books in EPUB, EPUB3, and Mobi formats
- Digital Braille books
