WELCOME TO THE CAMPUS


The **School of Agricultural Science and Veterinary Medicine** was established in 2013 after the latest Italian University reform when the former Faculty of Agricultural Sciences and the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine merged.

Presently, the School accounts for around 4,000 students (undergraduate and graduate).

The *Agripolis* campus is in Legnaro, a small town in the south of Padova.


It includes also the <u>Veterinary Teaching Hospital</u>, the <u>"Lucio Toniolo" experimental farm</u>, the Regional Agency for Agriculture ("<u>Veneto Agricoltura</u>"), the <u>Regional Institute for Animal Health and Disease</u> and many agricultural and student associations.

While most lectures take place on the main campus, some programmes may include classes in **Vicenza** and **Conegliano**.







Here you can find most Professors' offices, as well as laboratories and lecture rooms (on the ground floor).



The Veterinary Medicine building

In the "Museum" building you can find the laboratories of the Department Of Comparative Biomedicine And Food Science (BCA), but also the Educational Museum of Veterinary Medicine. It offers precious insights into the world of vertebrate species and their qualities, and it spreads all over the building: for example, you might find yourself refilling your water bottle next to the skeleton of a bovine...









OVUD - The Veterinary Teaching Hospital

Behind you can see the VTH, also known as OVUD. It is managed by the Department of Animal Medicine, Production and Health (MAPS). It consists of 20 units that provide medical care for both traditional and non-traditional animals, livestock, and equines. The hospital offers 24/7 emergency veterinary services for animal owners. Here students of Veterinary Medicine carry out their mandatory traineeship.











II Pentagono



Next stop: the *Pentagono*.

This building owes its name to its peculiar shape.

Here, you will find lecture rooms and laboratories, as well as admin offices and study spaces.
On the third floor is the library.

The "Pietro Arduino" library

The Regional Agency for Agriculture "Veneto Agricoltura"

The semi-circular building belongs to the Regional Agency for Agriculture "Veneto Agricoltura".

Veneto Agricoltura is the Veneto Region's Agency for Innovation in the Primary Sector, and

- → it supports the Regional Committee in the development of policies concerning farming, agro-food, forestry, and fisheries sectors
- → it aims at encouraging innovation and promoting environmental sustainability
- → it provides specialist services for the enhancement and commercialization of typical regional products
- → it supports applied research, carrying out activities within European, national, and regional projects.







At the end of the path is *Ca' Gialla* ("The yellow House").

Next to the entrance, on the right, you will often see people hanging out and getting something to drink from the cafeteria.

At Ca' Gialla you will find classes and laboratories. On the second floor are the admin offices for the BCA and MPAS departments; on the first floor there is the canteen. Don't forget: to access the canteens you need to use your *Tesserino Mensa*.





"Lucio Toniolo" Experimental farm





The "Lucio Toniolo" experimental farm was set up in 1960 and currently occupies an area of 68 hectares.

Also located near the farm are the premises of the National Institute of Nuclear Physics (INFN) and the Regional Institute for Animal Health and Disease (Istituto zooprofilattico delle Venezie), a public veterinary institute.

The farm is equipped with greenhouses, stalls, and an agrometeorological station used daily for logging data, plus machinery including tractors and seeders.


Its activities include teaching, experimental work, and crop cultivation, as well as the maintenance of green assets on the entire campus.



Corte Benedettina

The Corte Benedettina, which dates back to the 15th century, used to be a monastery and has now been converted to university use: the number of degree programmes and students keeps growing!

It takes only a few minutes to go from the campus to the *Corte*: follow the directions to *Scuola di Agraria e Medicina Veterinaria / School of Agricultural Sciences* and *Veterinary Medicine*.
